Motion was made by Mr. Ulrich, seconded by Mrs. Bieselin, and carried when all board members present voted in favor to approve resolution that the employee named in executive session shall be suspended without pay effective immediately for a period of thirty (30) days pending a determination and a hearing pursuant to the aforesaid statute.

Meeting adjourned at 10:25 p.m. on motion by Mrs. LaRosa, seconded by Mrs. Bieselin, and carried when all board members present voted in favor.
