- 1. *District security responsibilities*: The district is in the process of receiving permits from outside organizations for the 2017-2018 school year. In an effort to ensure the appropriate use of facilities, security will have a greater presence during afterschool, evening, and weekend activities. Expansion of camera coverage will assist in this regard.
- 2. Bond bid awards and Phase 2 scheduling: Most bids for summer work have been submitted and were reviewed by the Finance Committee. Work should begin at designated locations as soon as possible after school ends.
- 3. *Districtwide field signage*: New and improved signage will be added to all district fields over the summer, including but not limited to those addressing smoking, drinking, and dog-walking.
- 4. *PJ Bellew Sewer Line Problem:* An underground sewer line was cracked and damaged during the August 2016 playground installation. The contractor returned on Saturday, May 27 and successfully repaired the sewer line.
- 5. *Masera Parking Lot Expansion:* ES BOCES was approached by the district about assuming responsibility for clearing some of its parking lots during snow events. They have not yet responded.
- 6. *LED conversion:* PSEG Electric Utility has approved the district's rebate applications for conversion from T8 lamps to LED at all buildings. The rebate value should provide potentially 100% reimbursement to the district and significant future utility cost savings.
- 7. *Udall Boulder Donation:* Rock Solid will begin the installation of a small decorative border and engraved boulder at the Udall main entrance. Contractor insurance will be provided and the job will be done before the end of this school year.
- 8. Fire inspections are scheduled for July 2017.
