Discussion Items:

- TAN/BAN Results On July 23 the District went out for a \$19 million Tax Anticipation Note (TAN) and a \$37.4 million Bond Anticipation Note (BAN). The net interest rate for the TAN and BAN were 1.35% and 1.37%, respectively.
- The District received an inquiry about the rent from Ask US that was discussed. Ask US is looking for a reduction in the usage of the gymnasium and would like a corresponding decrease in the rent. The lease agreement expires in June 2020 and will be reevaluated at that time.
- Preliminary fund balance was discussed for the 2018-2019 school year.
- The District will be engaging New York State School Boards Association (NYSSBA) for a complete policy update, which will include the update of our entire policy manual as well as putting our policy manual in an e-policy format online. This process will take approximately 12-24 months.
