Recent/current problems include; temperature control, water clarity issues, liner leaks, liner bubbles, liner discolored patches, leaks in drainage grates, gutter system leaks, drain pipe corrosion, floor drainage blockages, drain to creek concerns, automatic water feeder, unequal pumping characteristics, old piping, spalling/cracked concrete, etc.
 - b. Near future issues include; HVAC unit unreliable, baseboard wall steam cracks, deck tile issues, filter tanks old, pvc and metal piping old, some linkage valves old, chlorinator, heat exchanger, steam connections, rooftop/lower gym AHU/heat, etc.
 - c. Replacement project will cost \$7.3 million for 5 lane, and \$11.3 million for 6 lane.
