Every fall, the West Islip Counseling Department invites local colleges and universities to meet with interested students for our on-site registration days. Throughout November, admissions representatives from local colleges will meet with seniors for approximately 15 minutes each to review their application, transcript, required test scores and any additional material they may have. Decisions may be made immediately and scholarships may be awarded on the spot. Most colleges will waive their application fees and the wait for a decision that is associated with the traditional application process is often eliminated. Students may register for on-site registration at least two weeks prior to each college's registration date.

**SUNY Brockport: 10:00 AM**

- GPA between 88 & 92
- SUNY App must be completed & submitted prior to meeting via SUNY or Common App
- Bring in copy of score reports for SAT of 1080-1120 and/or ACT of 22-25
- letter of recommendation & essay

## November 21<sup>st</sup>

### Molloy College: 9:00 AM

- fee waived
- 1030 combined on the NEW SAT (ACT Composite Score of 20 or higher)
- GPA should be no less than an 80 average
- Students should complete a paper application (available in counseling office), essay, SAT/ACT scores
- Students applying to any music or theatre programs will be accepted to the college contingent upon auditions
- Students applying to Nursing Program may sit for the on-site.

**ALL MATERIALS DUE TO COUNSELOR BY NOV. 17<sup>th</sup>**

## November 28<sup>th</sup>

### St. John's University: 9:00 AM

- no fee waiver code required
- minimum cumulative GPA of 85
- minimum SAT of 980, including minimum SAT Math score of 440
- minimum ACT Composite score of 19 including: minimum ACT Math score of 17 & minimum ACT English score of 16
- Submit an online application to St. John's Univ. at least one week prior to the on-site decision day. Applications may be submitted via Common App or the SJU application (both available online at [stjohns.edu/apply](http://stjohns.edu/apply))
- printed copy of submitted application. If applying via Common App, it MUST include the SJU member page
- standardized test scores for all test dates (SAT &/or ACT)
- Personal essay, resume, or letters of recommendation are not required, although they are encouraged.

**ALL MATERIALS DUE TO COUNSELOR BY NOV. 22<sup>nd</sup>**

## December 4<sup>th</sup>

### C.W. Post – LIU: 9:00 AM

- fee waived
- completed application on-line either through the Common App or CW Post's website (code: "fee waiver") & print out for their appointment
- essay required, letter of recommendation
- minimum SAT score of 900/GPA above 75, recommended/minimum ACT score of 19
- SAT/ACT scores to be printed & submitted by student
- Please include your official standardized score report with other required materials for your counselor.

### December 7<sup>th</sup>

#### St. Joseph's College: 9:00 AM

- fee waived
- Complete & submit paper application or use SJC Online application (prior to meeting) or Common App
- on-line application can be accessed at <http://www.sjcnj.edu/applynow>, use promo code LIOSHS
- ACT/SAT scores
- essay, letter of recommendation & activities resume can be submitted day of on-site or any time after then
- B average (mid-80's) & at least 1100 SAT (Math/Critical Reading only) or a 21 ACT

#### ALL MATERIALS DUE TO COUNSELOR BY DEC. 5<sup>th</sup>

### December 12<sup>th</sup>

#### Adelphi University: 9:00 AM

- fee waived
- GPA: minimum of 83% unweighted average
- SAT: minimum of 1090/ACT: minimum of 21
- SAT and/or ACT (with writing) scores to be printed & submitted by student
- one or more recommendation letters
- essay
- Must complete & submit an online application through the Common App or Adelphi Univ. App at least 48 hours prior to meeting. Check off "fee waive" option. (fee waiver code is: ADELPHI)
- Resume (not mandatory but highly encouraged)

#### ALL MATERIALS DUE TO COUNSELOR BY DEC. 8<sup>th</sup>

### December 19<sup>th</sup>

#### Mercy College: 9:00 AM

- fee waived (no fee waiver code needed)
- Students must apply at <https://www.mercy.edu/apply-now/undergraduate-application>
- minimum GPA of 79
- essays & letters of recommendation optional, but recommended
- SAT/ACT optional, to be printed & submitted by student

**Suffolk Community College: 8:30 AM**

- fee waived on appointment day. Application fee will be charged upon enrollment to the college.

- fee waived on appointment day. Application fee will be charged upon enrollment to the college.
