**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

**West Islip Enrichment Program:** The West Islip Enrichment Program will offer enrichment courses to the children of West Islip residents who are attending Kindergarten, through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, including students who attend parochial or private school. Children will be grouped by age based on applicant enrollment. This program is completely self-sustaining. It is funded by course fees, so there is no cost to local taxpayers.
