PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

West Islip Enrichment Program:
The West Islip Enrichment Program
will offer enrichment courses to the
children of West Islip residents who
have already completed Kindergarten, through
8th grade, including students who attend
parochial or private school. Children will be
grouped by appropriate age based on
applicant enrollment.

This program is completely self-sustaining. It
is funded by course fees, so there is no cost to
local taxpayers.

Super Delta Dart: E. Ermanovics

Come build and fly your own SUPER
DELTA DART. This attractive rubber
band powered airplane with good
flying capabilities, features a balsa
wood frame and paper covered wings
that span 21 inches. Building the
model is easy and straight forward.
Using simple to handle tools such as a
hobby knife, scissors, straight pins and
white glue boys and girls will have no
trouble assembling all parts of the
airplane from an assortment of
premeasured and precut color coded
balsa wood strips. The addition of a
propeller and rubber band motor
completes the construction process
making the SUPER DELTA DART a
truly fun to fly model airplane.

Prior model building experience is not
required.

Dragster Design and Construction:

covered will be getting jobs, will discuss
pay and more. Students will receive a
certificate, charts and booklets.

This class is for beginners as well as for
students who know how to sew. Students
will learn several sewing stitches and learn
how to sew on buttons. Projects include
sewing a teddy bear and a purse. All

Introduction to Theater: S. Shaffi

Coding is Cool Part 1: **C. Maniscalco**

Students will learn to code by starting with a short simple program. They will then advance to bigger projects at their own pace. Students will gain technical and creative skills as they begin to code, program and animate a custom video game.

Students will have access to step-by-step tutorials that walk them through programming projects as well as encourage further exploration.
