


# Connect your Chromebook to Wi-Fi out of District

All Chromebooks used within the district should automatically find the Wi-Fi connection



**Outside of the district, to connect to the Internet, use a compatible Wi-Fi network.**

## Step 1: Turn on Wi-Fi

1. Turn on your Chromebook.
2. Click on the network . (Should say no network)  
**Note:** If you see "Connected to" and your Wi-Fi network name, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.
3. To turn on Wi-Fi, click the switch.
4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list. Proceed to the options below.

## Step 2: Pick a network and connect

### Connect to an OPEN network

1. Click the Wi-Fi network .

**Note:** Your information might be visible to other people on this network. This might be a guest network in a location such as a hotel, airport, Starbucks, Optimumwifi, etc.

### Connect to a SECURE network

1. Click the secure Wi-Fi network .

**Note:** Secure networks should have the Wi-Fi icon and a lock

2. Type the network password.
3. Click **Connect**.

## Wi-Fi networks that work with Chromebooks

- Open networks that don't require a password
  - Secure networks that use WEP, Dynamic WEP, WPA-PSK, WPA-Enterprise, or WPA2-Enterprise settings
    - Recommended to use WPA2, as it is more secure than WEP or WPA
  - Standards: 802.11 a/b/g/n and 802.11ac for AC-equipped Chromebooks
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
