Registration Process

1. Complete a registration form (www.msd.k12.ny.us) with your school guidance counselor. (If taking a full course, you can only register if you did not pass the course during the year.)
2. When completed, your school counselor or school designee must sign and approve your registration form. Non-district Only - If applicable, a copy of 504/IEP plan must be attached.
3. Registration must be completed in person on the dates stated above. Please use the following checklist. (No mail or phone registrations)

Course Information

- Any course listed will only run if 15 or more students register
- All course periods/sections are subject to change prior to the start date
- A student may only repeat full courses if she/he received a failing grade
 - *Exception for Enrichment - PC Apps and Health*
- It is not advisable to enroll in three courses (Home principal approval)

Transportation

- Transportation is not provided by the district
- Student arrival is in main parking lot and student dismissal is in South parking lot (Please drive slowly for the safety of all our students)
