Our requested supply list is as follows-- it looks like a massive amount, but we will use it all! Also, for some items we suggest the brand name, as from experience, we know what works best.

- 2 Composition Notebooks (Primary Books, from Staples)
- 30 sharpened YELLOW pencils
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola Crayons (no florescent, pearl, marble or twistables please!)
- 1 box of 8 Crayola Crayons
- 4 bottom (sturdy) pocket folders
- 1 scissors (Fiskars work best)
- 1 pack of washable *thin* markers
- 1 pack of washable **thick** markers
- 1 large "baby wipe" container and 2 refill packs (we get good and dirty every day!)
- 2 dry erase markers
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 4 tennis balls (can be used, please cut a 2" "X" and place in a separate bag please)
- 30 glue sticks
- 4 pack of play-doh
- A backpack large enough to carry folder, notebook and lunch/snacks to and from school (*no wheelies*)
- An oversized tee shirt to be used as a smock
- A change of clothes (shirt, underwear, socks, pants) in a bag labeled with name
- \$7.00 check for "Scholastic," weekly magazine
